GRANT POLICIES & GUIDELINES

Funds and Associated Grants:

Our organization provides various types of grants to support different causes and communities. These grants are distributed from our Care & Relief Funds, GiverArmy Funds, and Scholarships.

Care & Relief Funds:

These are crowdfunded funds that address a specific community's needs amid a tragedy like a natural disaster, a school shooting, or any other nationally recognized crisis for a specified community. We crowdfund on GiveSendGo.com to receive funds from anyone who cares about the situation. Grants are first distributed to qualifying campaigns on GiveSendGo.com and then to local nonprofits in the crisis area that are acting as first responders for their community.

To qualify for a Care & Relief grant:

1. You must have a verified campaign on GiveSendGo.com related to one of our Care & Relief Funds.
2. The campaign must have a reasonable financial goal, fulfill a charitable purpose (humanitarian, which includes individual needs, faith-based, educational, or scientific), and clearly describe the pressing need and how the funds will be used to meet that need.

To increase one's odds of receiving a grant, we suggest that they independently raise 5-10% of their goal, have one or more campaign updates, a personalized thank you note, a unique GSG URL, and a connected social media account.

GiverArmy Funds:

The GiverArmy creates crowdfunded grants associated with ten different charitable causes. These grants are given only to qualifying campaigns on GiveSendGo.com. If possible, a campaign must be verified with a social media link, clearly describe the recipients' current needs and how the funds will meet those needs, and have a reasonable campaign goal to qualify for a GiverArmy grant.

We do not give grants to unclear campaigns or campaigns that have unrealistic goals. Though one may apply for a GiverArmy grant, grants are distributed by a committee

that searches for qualifying campaigns in need. You can even endorse a specific campaign if they are eligible.

Scholarships:

These grants are awarded to individuals who have been accepted into a specific program and demonstrate excellence in work ethic and academia within the context of the scholarship. Applicants can apply for scholarships at GiveSendGo.org. Each scholarship will have its criteria for qualification unique to the scholarship itself.

Depending on the scholarship, grants can cover half or the whole financial need. For example, some scholarships are faith-based, and applicants must show that the pursuit of faith-based education has already been a part of their educational pursuits.

Grantee Obligations and Follow-Ups:

Every individual that is awarded a grant is responsible for indicating the full use of the grant. They must utilize one of the following steps to fulfill their grant obligation.

Approved forms of grant follow-ups:

1. **Grantee Follow-Up Form:** Each grantee will receive a follow-up form where they can provide updates for the donors who made the grant possible.
2. **Campaign Update:** New updates on their campaign indicating the use of the grant funds.
3. **Spotlight Interview:** Each grantee will have the option to be interviewed by the charity, where they can express their gratitude and utilization of the given grant.

Multiple Grants for Volunteer Projects:

We may award multiple grants to campaigns that benefit a specific charitable project within a community. Grants may be specially awarded to individuals or groups seeking to increase their community service efforts. Grantees may join our SEND Network (A network of on-the-ground volunteers seeking to better their community). Participation in our SEND Network can alleviate the financial responsibility of a project and can take on our sponsorship of the project itself. Grants for volunteer projects are the only category that may apply multiple times for a grant. To apply for this grant, one must also apply to be a GiveSendGo Charities volunteer.

Disclosures:

GiveSendGo Charities is not obligated to provide a grant to any campaign even if they fully qualify. All grant amounts are subject to change based on the funds available. The improper use of a grant is subject to investigation and disciplinary action, including the enforced return of the grant. In the event of improper use of a grant, one may be

banned from utilizing the crowdfunding platform [GiveSendGo.com](https://www.givesendgo.com) and will be blocked from receiving a grant from us again.
